

Corseted Tiebacks contains:

- Patterns and instructions to make a grommet closure tieback (View A).
- Patterns and instructions to make a button closure tieback (View B).

Suggested Fabrics: Light to medium weight fabrics, such as cottons, silks and polyesters. Light weight suedes and leathers may be used with some alterations to pattern instructions.

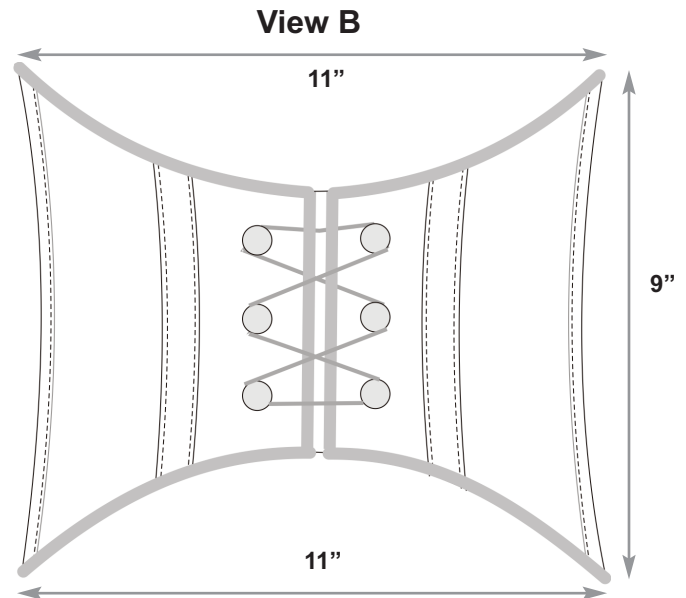
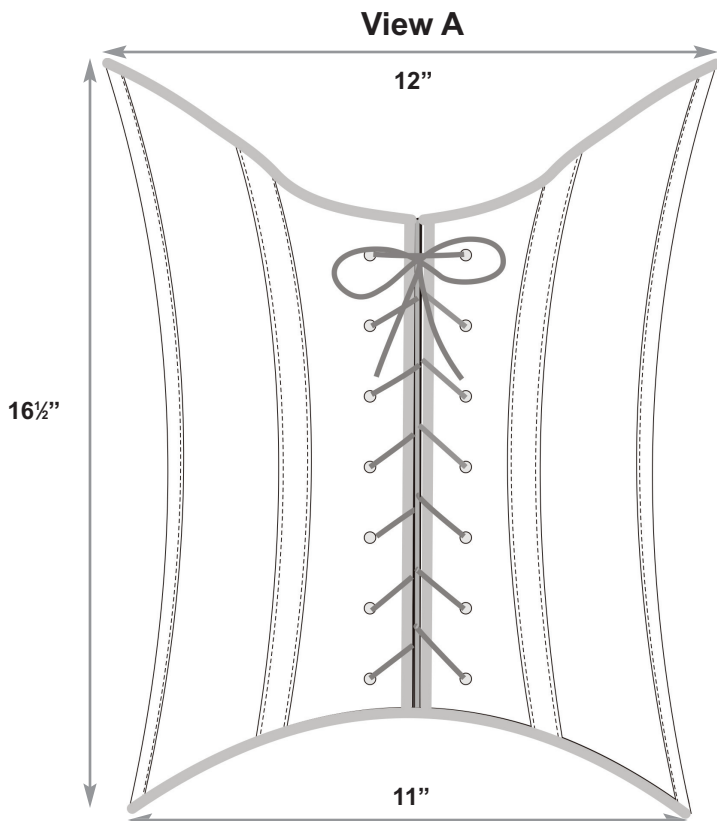
Yardages: **View A:** 1½ yards face fabric and ¾ yard contrast lining for 1 tieback, 1 yard face fabric and ¾ yard contrast lining for each additional tieback.

View B: 1¼ yards face fabric and ½ yard contrast lining for 1 tieback, 1 yard face fabric and ½ yard contrast lining for each additional tieback.

Supplies: **View A:** 14 - ¼" grommets, 2 yards cotton covered boning, 3 yards traverse rod cord or stiff ⅛" cord. Optional: beads for end of lacing.

View B: 6 buttons, 1 yard cotton covered boning, 2 yards traverse rod cord or stiff ⅛" cord, 1½ yards ribbon or rattail cord.

Difficulty Level: Intermediate to Advanced
