

Ribbon Edge Panel contains:

- Instructions to make a pleated panel with an undulating, two color ribbon detail on the leading edge.
- Choice of pleat styles: goblet pleats or french triple pleats.
- Instructions included for single width panels may be modified for multiple widths.

Suggested Fabrics: Any light to medium weight fabrics. Examples include cottons, silks, linens, or other natural fibers. Heavy or thick fabrics, such as upholstery fabrics, are not suitable.

Yardages for one (1) panel:

Solid Fabrics: Face fabric: Finished panel length plus 18"
 Ribbon Accent fabric #1: 1½ yards
 Ribbon Accent fabric #2: 1½ yards
 Lining: Finished panel length plus 6"
 Interlining: Finished panel length plus 9" (Optional)

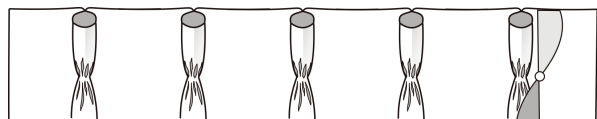
Print Fabrics: Face fabric: Finished panel length plus 18", plus repeat.
 Ribbon Accent fabric #1: 1½ yards
 Ribbon Accent fabric #2: 1½ yards
 Lining: Finished panel length plus 6"
 Interlining: Finished panel length plus 9" (Optional)

Note: Save yardage on accent fabrics by ordering an extra ½ yard for each additional panel being constructed.

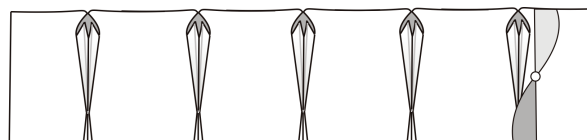
Supplies: 4" buckram for header and hem ironing guide, drapery pins, drapery weights for corners and seams, thread, buttons (1 button for every 8" in panel length). A t-square and drapery table or other large flat table for assembling panels is highly recommended.

Difficulty Level: Intermediate
