

Layered Pleated Panel contains:

- Instructions to make a Euro pleated panel with five overlapping layers.
- Instructions included for single width panels.

Suggested Fabrics: Any light to medium weight fabrics. Examples include cottons, silks, linens, or other natural fibers. Heavy or thick fabrics, such as upholstery fabrics, are not suitable.

Yardages for one (1) panel with solid fabric (yardage will vary for repeats):

Layer 1: Finished panel length divided by 5 plus 11", plus yardage for squaring

Layer 2: Finished panel length divided by 5 plus 5¼", plus yardage for squaring

Layer 3: Finished panel length divided by 5 plus 5¼", plus yardage for squaring

Layer 4: Finished panel length divided by 5 plus 5¼", plus yardage for squaring

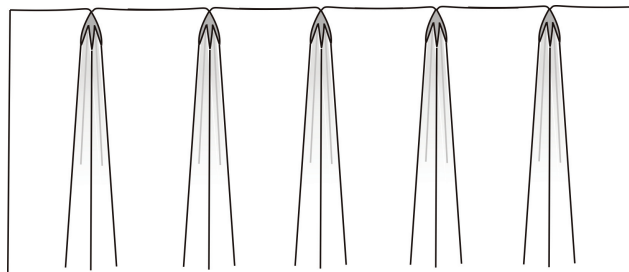
Layer 5: Finished panel length divided by 5 plus 6¾", plus yardage for squaring

Interlining (Optional): Cuts in the same lengths as above

Lining: Finished panel length times 2.25 (ex: FL=100", lining length of 225" needed)

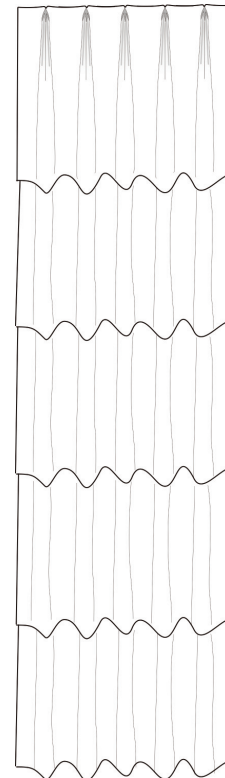
Supplies: 4" buckram for header, drapery pins, drapery weights for corners, thread, a t-square and drapery table or other large flat table for assembling panels is highly recommended.

Difficulty Level: Intermediate
